- as an instructional leader, including an ability to embed a culture of high expectation of student learning and build expert teacher practice which is evidence based and high impact.

Leading improvement, innovation and change

- for strategic leadership focussing on leadership for innovation and change, and an ability to design and implement high leverage improvement plans.

Leading the management of the school

- to ensure that the school's human, physical and financial resources are efficiently allocated and managed, including ongoing compliance with the Child Safe Standards and the Victorian Registration and Qualification Authority.

Engagement

- to develop positive relationships with students; parents and families; the local parish and wider community; and participate and contribute to DOSCEL activities.

Community

- to develop high aspirations and expectations through fostering community relationships and leading an innovative school program which maximises the opportunity for all students.
