What You Need to Know About the Certificate of Religious Education – Diocese of Sale 2017

OVERVIEW OF THE CERTIFICATE OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The **Certificate of Religious Education – Diocese of Sale** is offered to teachers who are not accredited to teach Religious Education (RE) in a Catholic School.

Accreditation to Teach RE in a Catholic School

Accreditation to Teach RE in a Catholic School is achieved through the successful completion of *eight units* over a *two-year* cycle (four units per year).

- *This course has two components:*
 1. Compulsory class attendance
 2. Successfully completed assignments
- As the course is taught over a two-year cycle, failure to attend a unit means that you have to wait two years before the unit will be offered again.
- The course must be completed within **four years** of commencement unless the written permission of the Course Director is given.

Accreditation to Teach in a Catholic School

Each unit also carries hours towards **Accreditation to Teach in a Catholic School**. (7 hours per day)

COST PER UNIT

For those working in a Catholic school

The cost is **\$120.00 per unit**. The CEOSale will invoice your school for your course fee at the end of each term. Please ensure that this arrangement is confirmed with your Principal.

For those not working in a Catholic school

The cost is **\$132.00 per unit**. The CEOSale will invoice you personally each term. This cost includes the GST (not payable by schools).

Replacement funding

The CEOSale pays replacement funding for teachers in Catholic primary schools in the Diocese of Sale.

COMPULSORY COURSE BOOKS

The following books are required to be purchased for the Course.

- *Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church*
- *At Home with God's People*
- *So You're Working for the Catholic Church*
- *YouCat*

A total of \$66.10 is required for these books. These books will be used as references in each of the course units.

Additional prescribed references for each unit are also required to be purchased.

Some compulsory course books will be available for purchase at the venue.

 - Log in to IPLS via CEVN.
 - Go to find *My PL (IPLS) Activities*,
 - Browse to the unit you wish to register for, click on the unit title
 - Read important information in the advertisement
 - Scroll down and click on *Register*,
 - Fill out the RE Accreditation Application Form and submit
 - Return to the Registration Screen, tick you have your principal's approval and press *Click to Register*.
